Guidelines for participation of IUAC scientists and engineers in user experiments.

Since inception, scientists/engineers of IUAC may have two types of involvement in user experiments, as given below:

- 1. IUAC scientists/engineers may be involved in all stages of the experiment, viz., planning the experiment, execution of the experiment, data analysis/interpretation. In such cases she/he would be a co-author in any publication arising out of the work. No paper should be communicated by any user for publication in a journal or for a conference without the consent/comment by IUAC coauthor. Copy of the final paper after academic inputs/inclusions of names should be given to academic cell of IUAC.
- 2. IUAC scientists/engineers help the users in performing the experiment including Local Experiment Coordinator duty. In such cases their help should be acknowledged in the paper and they would not be coauthors in the publications resulting from the work.

All users are requested to follow the above guidelines for smooth conduct of experiments at IUAC and for the publications arising out of such work.
